

## Slovenia Short-Term Mission Trip

- General info

- Traditionally, Slovenes are Roman Catholic (57.8% according to the 2002 Census) but like elsewhere in Europe the Roman Catholicism affiliation in Slovenia is dropping (71.6% according to the 1991 census), a drop of more than 1 % annually.
- Slovenia ranks number 16 on the list of countries by suicide rate. Croatia and Montenegro are the only other European countries with a nominally higher rate. All three of these countries were part of Yugoslavia in 1992.
- Slovenia is 7820 sq miles big, 1/4<sup>th</sup> the size of South Carolina which is 31200 sq miles in size.



- Trip Details

- Assist local pastor's ministry to the Slovenians through teaching english and kid's camp, giving us an opportunity to build relationships and, in turn, attest God's love.
- 17 day trip (last week of June – first week of July)
- Room and board with local pastor and family

- Teaching english

- English comprehension is vital for employment in Slovenia. These classes are sponsored by the parent church.
- 10 evening sessions (consists of english folk singing, 2-hour classroom instruction, 30 minute bible study)

- Kid's camp

- Teaching english and God's word to local area kids between 5-12 years of age.
- 5 afternoon sessions (consists of singing, playing, classroom instruction)
